

Public Survey Results

35 respondents were not aware of the public's role in the Stormwater Runoff Program

16 were aware of their role

8 respondents actually admitted that they were doing nothing about it

32 were actively taking steps to prevent stormwater pollution

an interesting fact that only 16 respondents were aware of their role, but another 16 still did something about it on their own

There were a lot of people that swept up their grass cuttings and leaves, were careful about not dumping oil or other chemicals down the drain and cleaned up after their dog

Many people responded to the public programs that could be coming next year, including - the Annual Litter Cleanup, Tree Planting, and Installation of Dog Waste Stations

The overwhelming response was for Rain Barrels, Rain Gardens and Bioretention Projects
